For decades solid parquet has been the specialty of INPA Parket. The parquet is produced in our own parquet factory in a variety of dimensions and can be prefinished with oil or varnish.

These South American wood species are known worldwide under the brand name Chaco Wood. These wood species have a lively and warm appearance with the majority of them FSC certified. Other wood species such as oak are produced elsewhere.

All wood species are delivered untreated but can be varnished or oiled industrially on demand. Depending on the wood species other finishings such as brushing, smoking or coloring are also possible.
